Dr. Dany Gaspard is a Board-Certified Pulmonary and Critical Care physician and Clinical Assistant Professor at the LAU Gilbert and Rose-Marie Chagoury School of Medicine. He currently serves as the head of the Division of Pulmonary Medicine, where he combines clinical expertise with academic leadership.

Dr. Gaspard specializes in advanced bronchoscopy and Interventional Pulmonary Medicine, providing comprehensive care for a wide range of pulmonary conditions, including asthma, COPD, lung fibrosis, interstitial lung disease, pneumonia, pulmonary embolism, lung cancer, and sleep disorders. He is recognized for his dedication to patient-centered care and his active involvement in both clinical practice and procedural innovation.

Dr. Gaspard earned his M.D. from Saint Joseph University in Beirut in 2008 and completed residency training in Internal Medicine at Cooper University Hospital in Camden, New Jersey, in 2013. He subsequently pursued a Fellowship in Pulmonary and Critical Care Medicine in 2016, followed by specialized training in Interventional Pulmonary Medicine in 2017, also at Cooper University Hospital.

Dr. Gaspard is deeply committed to medical education, serving as a mentor and program director for Pulmonary and Critical Care fellows, as well as teaching residents and medical students through bedside and didactic sessions. His research spans multiple areas of Pulmonary and Critical Care Medicine, including vaping in the young Lebanese population, COPD and PRISM prevalence in Lebanese smokers, COVID pneumonia, war-related lung disease, and innovative interventions such as the use of vasopressors through peripheral IV lines.

He is an active member of numerous local and international professional societies, including the Lebanese Pulmonary Society, the Lebanese Society of Critical Care Medicine, the American Thoracic Society, and the Society of Critical Care Medicine.
