Dr. El Asmar obtained a Doctor of Medicine degree from the University Saint Joseph in 2016, he then went on to complete his Emergency Medicine Residency at the American University of Beirut Medical Center in 2020. His proficiency extends to being an EPIC (healthcare system) superuser, recognized and flagged by the EPIC team in 2018.

Dr. El Asmar's academic pursuits have been complemented by his business acumen, as he graduated in January of 2019 with a Business Management Diploma from the International Business Management Institute in Berlin. He then earned a Leading Healthcare Quality and Safety Certificate from The George Washington University in December of 2019 and also held the role of Administrative Chief Resident in the Emergency Medicine Department at the American University of Beirut Medical Center demonstrating his leadership skills and commitment to his field.
