The Gilbert and Rose-Marie Chagoury School of Medicine proudly announces the appointment of Dr. Kaissar Yammine as Clinical Associate Professor in the LAUSOM Department of Surgery-Orthopedic Surgery Division.

Dr. Yammine graduated from Saint Joseph University in Beirut in 1992. He subsequently pursued residency training in orthopedic surgery at the Faculty of Medicine of Université Pierre et Marie CURIE-Saint Antoine Campus in Paris, France. After graduation, Dr. Yammine completed a clinical fellowship in foot and ankle surgery at the Clinique des Lilas, followed by another clinical fellowship as chief of clinic in orthopedic traumatology and hand surgery in Lafontaine Saint Denis Hospital-Paris, France.

In 2000, Dr. Yammine returned to Lebanon and worked as a consultant orthopedic surgeon in several hospitals, including Rizk Hospital, from 2004 to 2007. He was then appointed as professor of anatomy and sports science at Antonine University.

In 2007, Dr. Yammine joined the Emirates Hospital in Dubai as head of the Foot and Hand Clinic and established a busy clinical practice. He was also a professor of anatomy at the American University of Science & Technology in Al Ain, UAE.

Despite a busy clinical career, Dr. Yammine earned a master's degree in public health with distinction from the Faculty of Medical Sciences at the University of Manchester in 2010. He also completed a PhD in medical education from a joint program with Ambrosiana University in Italy and the University of Calgary. His thesis was the first meta-analysis in the field of medical education research and was published in the *Anatomical Sciences Education Journal*.

In 2014, Dr. Yammine was named associate professor in medical education at Ambrosiana University.

Dr. Yammine is the author of more than 48 peer-reviewed publications, with 27 meta-analyses. His research areas cover basic, clinical and medical education research. He also acts as reviewer to the following journals: *BMJ Open*, *Anatomical Sciences Education*, *BMC Medical Education*, *Clinical Anatomy*, *Sports Medicine*, *Surgical & Radiological Anatomy*, *Journal of Rheumatology* and *Journal of Minerva Ortopedica e Traumatologica*.
