Dr. Charbel Rameh is a specialist in Otolaryngology and Head and Neck Surgery. He obtained his Bachelor of Science and Doctor of Medicine degrees from the American University of Beirut (AUB), where he also completed his residency in Otolaryngology–Head and Neck Surgery at the American University of Beirut Medical Center. Following his training in Lebanon, he pursued a fellowship in Otology and Neurotology in Marseille, France, where he specialized in ear and balance disorders.

Dr. Rameh has been in clinical practice in Lebanon since 2010, gaining extensive experience in the diagnosis and management of a wide range of ear, nose, throat,

head, and neck pathologies. In addition to his clinical work, he serves as a Clinical Assistant Professor and is actively involved in teaching medical students and residents.

A dedicated academic and researcher, Dr. Rameh has authored more than thirty-five scientific publications and continues to contribute to ongoing research projects in the field of Otolaryngology.
