Dr. Abillama graduated in 1990 from Rene Descartes University at Cochin University Hospital in France with a degree in Critical Care and Anesthesiology. He then worked in France for ten years and then moved to Lebanon where he practiced as a Critical Care physician.

Dr. Abillama holds a diploma in Clinical Pharmacology and Toxicology from Paris VII University, completed in 1991. He specializes in Clinical Intensive Care, Parenteral Nutrition, and Medical Ethics.

Dr. Abillama has significant experience with wounded soldiers, mainly acquired during the 2007 Nahr el Bared battle. In parallel, he was elected President of the Lebanese Critical Care Society where he organized seminars as well as national and regional congresses. Moreover, he organized the first ultrasound seminars dedicated to Reanimation.

Dr. Abillama boasts a strong record of academic achievements, marked by numerous published articles and frequent presentations at international conferences, particularly in the fields of resuscitation and nutrition.

Dr. Abillama is highly interested in the issue of ethics, which is reflected in his past participation in medical ethics committees within LAUMCs' hospital and conducted awareness campaigns on Basic Life Support (BLS) directed at the general public.

Dr. Abillama has been involved in national campaigning with the National Organization for Organ and Tissue Donation and Transplant (NOD-Ib) in Lebanon.
