Dr. Radwan Zahreddine is a gastroenterologist and part-time Associated Clinician and Clinical Instructor in the Department of Internal Medicine, Division of Gastroenterology.

Dr. Zahreddine completed his medical studies at the Free University of Brussels in Belgium, where he also pursued his training in internal medicine and gastroenterology at Braine L'Alleud-Waterloo Hospital, Centre Paul-Brien, and Erasme Hospital. From 1987 to 1989, and later from 1993 until 2018, Dr. Zahreddine served as a clinical instructor of gastroenterology and a medical training instructor at the Faculty of Medicine of the Lebanese University, where he contributed to shaping the next generation of physicians.

In addition to his academic involvement, he held several leadership roles, including serving as Head of Internal Medicine and Gastroenterology Departments at Al Zahraa University Hospital in Beirut from 1992 to 2007, and as Head of the Gastroenterology Department at Bahman Hospital from 2007 to 2012.

Throughout his career, Dr. Zahreddine has played a pivotal role in advancing the field of gastroenterology and digestive endoscopy in Lebanon. He was among the first gastroenterologists in the country to introduce diagnostic and therapeutic bilio-pancreatic endoscopy (ERCP), as well as gastroscopy and colonoscopy, significantly expanding the scope of diagnostic and treatment options available to patients.

He has actively participated in numerous scientific congresses and professional gatherings, further contributing to the advancement of gastroenterology as both a clinical practice and a scientific discipline. His professional interests lie in clinical practice within internal medicine and gastroenterology, with a particular passion for teaching, training, and capacity building in the medical field.

Dr. Zahreddine is a longstanding member of the Lebanese Order of Physicians since 1986 and has been part of the Lebanese Society of Gastroenterology since 1993. His areas of expertise include diagnostic and therapeutic gastroscopy, colonoscopy, ERCP, and proctology, reflecting his commitment to both clinical excellence and innovation in gastroenterology.
