Dr. Chadi Murr is a Lebanese-Italian plastic and reconstructive surgeon whose career reflects a blend of rigorous European training, international experience, and a strong academic and clinical presence in Lebanon. Dr. Murr earned his Doctor of Medicine degree from the Faculty of Medicine and Surgery at the University of Pisa in 2005, graduating with a thesis on breast reconstruction following skin-sparing mastectomy. Soon after, he secured both Italian and Lebanese medical licenses, establishing the foundation for a distinguished career in reconstructive and aesthetic surgery.

Dr. Murr completed his residency in Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery at the University Hospital of

Siena and the Hospital of Pisa, where he also trained in the Burn Centre. To further broaden his expertise, he pursued advanced training in Brazil, where he gained experience in hand surgery, microsurgery, craniofacial reconstruction, and aesthetic practice under the mentorship of Professors Pedro Dyacir Escobar Martins and Jefferson Braga Silva, as well as Dr. Kleber Fisch. He also trained at the world-renowned Ivo Pitanguy Institute in Rio de Janeiro. In 2011, he finalized his specialization in Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery in Siena with a thesis focused on thoracic malformation repair in patients with Poland syndrome. Upon his return to Lebanon, Dr. Murr established himself as both a clinician and academic.

Since 2012, he has served as an instructor at the Lebanese American University Medical Center–Rizk Hospital, the Central Military Hospital in Badaro, the Hospital Français du Levant, and LAUMC–St. John Jounieh. His practice extends beyond Lebanon, as he continues to serve as a visiting doctor at the Ledra Clinic in Nicosia, Cyprus, and more recently as a Clinical Associate at the American University of Beirut.

His clinical expertise encompasses reconstructive breast surgery, congenital thoracic malformation repair, cleft lip and palate reconstruction, craniofacial surgery, burn management, and cosmetic procedures including body contouring and facial surgery. He has contributed to multiple publications in the field, particularly in reconstructive techniques and burn care.

Dr. Murr is an active member of several professional societies, including the Brazilian Society of Plastic Surgery, the Italian Society of Plastic Surgery, the Lebanese Society of Plastic Surgery, and the Italian Association Against Melanoma. His career reflects a deep commitment to advancing surgical innovation, medical education, and patient care, with a focus on integrating international standards into his practice in Lebanon and the region.
