Dr. Jeanine Menassa is the former Head of the Division of Rheumatology at the Lebanese University and currently serves as an Assistant Professor of Medicine at the Lebanese American University. She graduated from the Lebanese University in Beirut before pursuing a French diploma in rheumatology at the University of Lyon, France, and later earned an additional diploma from the American University of Beirut.

A pioneer in her field, Dr. Menassa was among the first to introduce musculoskeletal ultrasound into rheumatology practice in Lebanon. She holds a university diploma in musculoskeletal ultrasound from Pitié-Salpêtrière Hospital in Paris and is a certified EULAR ultrasound teacher, actively contributing to advancing clinical training in this area.
