A graduate of the University of Lyon, France, Dr. Ferzli holds a diploma from both the French University and the French State, marking his specialization in gastroenterology since 1978.

Throughout his career, Dr. Ferzli has remained deeply involved in both patient care and medical education. He has been a dedicated lecturer at the Lebanese University for more than ten years and later served as an Instructor of Clinical Medicine in Gastroenterology at the Lebanese American University (LAU).
